As per schedule and arrangement, a Regional Seminar on “**Securities Market: A Connectivity to Wealth Creation!**” was organized by Bhubaneswar Stock Exchange Ltd. (BhSE) in association with Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 at 9.30 A.M. at Hotel New Marion, Janpath, Bhubaneswar. Mr. Harun Rashid Khan, Dy. Governor, Reserve Bank of India, Mr. J. Ranganayakulu, Executive Director, SEBI, Mr. Madhab Reddy, Managing Director, Calcutta Stock Exchange, Mr. K.N. Ravindra, Secretary, NALCO and Shareholder Director, BhSE, Mr. Vivek Pattanayak, Chairman, BhSE and Mr. Debaraj Biswal, Chief Executive Officer, BhSE inaugurated the seminar by lightening the lamp.

Mr. Debaraj Biswal introduced the dignitaries of the inaugural session and made short introduction of the theme. Mr. Harun Rashid Khan as the Guest of Honor of the function in his address put emphasis on present economic scenario and highlighted the contribution of securities market to the growth of economy. Mr. Madhab Reddy highlighted the role of regional stock exchanges for the growth of securities market and viewed that revival of business on regional stock exchange should be facilitated in terms of Sec. 13 of the SCRA. Mr. K.N. Ravindra made a focus on duties and responsibilities of independent directors on the Board of corporate houses in the interest of investing public and viewed that considering this there was a need to review the manner of appointment of independent directors. The other Guest of Honor and Chief Speaker of the function, Shri J. Ranganayakulu highlighted the role and responsibilities of SEBI for promoting and regulating the securities market in the interest of the investors in securities. Shri Vivek Pattanayak, Chairperson of the session while highlighting the objectives of the stock exchange, stressed need of strengthening and existence of regional stock exchanges for spreading financial literacy for growth of investor population in the interest of the securities market and economy.

Before conclusion of session, the quarterly bulletin for December, 2011 published by Bhubaneswar Stock Exchange was released by the dignitaries. Then the copies of the bulletin were circulated among the participants present.

After inaugural session, there were two technical sessions.

First technical session was presided over by Shri A.K. Sabat, Chartered Accountant. There were two resource persons, namely, Shri Vikas Narnoli, AGM, SEBI who spoke on concept of primary market, how to read prospectus and invest in IPOs and Shri B.N. Sahoo, DGM, SEBI who made overview presentation on secondary market activities. Shri A.K. Sabat made an excellent summing up of the topics.

Second technical session was presided over by Dr. Banikant Mishra, Professor, Xavier Institute of Management, Bhubaneswar.
